2. Virus Bulletin Ltd (VB) reserves the right to charge interest on any outstanding payments from the due to date at the rate of 4% over the base rate of Lloyds TSB Bank Plc.
3. Cancellations will only be accepted if notified in writing (faxes and emails are acceptable) to VB. Cancellations are deemed to be effective from the date upon which the notice is received by VB.
4. If you cancel the booking, the following charges (based on the total value of the confirmed booking exclusive of VAT) will be immediately due and payable by you:
